Travel Resources

Getting to Laguna Beach

Driving

The Surf and Sand Resort is located on the Pacific Coast Highway between Los Angeles (roughly 50 miles south) and San Diego (roughly 70 miles north).

Due to the unpredictability of Southern California traffic, we recommend that you leave yourself ample travel time. You may use [this website](#) to monitor Orange County traffic conditions, and [this website](#) to monitor Los Angeles driving conditions.

Please also note that there will not be a fee for overnight parking at the Surf and Sand Resort. The normal \$30/night parking fee has been waived for WASSA conference participants.

By Air

There are a number of airports that you may want to consider. They are listed below from closest to furthest (from the Surf and Sand Resort):

Orange County John Wayne Airport (SNA) - 15 miles

SNA is by far the most convenient airport to consider both in terms of distance from the Surf and Sand Resort, and transportation that is least likely to be impacted by traffic. Fares may be slightly more expensive than LAX, however you will save time and money on ground transportation.

Long Beach Airport (LGB) - 30 miles

LGA is a small airport in Long Beach. It is more convenient than LAX, but there are not as many carriers to choose from (only Alaska / Horizon, Delta, Jet Blue, and US Air). Depending on when you arrive, you will have to deal with some traffic on the 405 Freeway South, but it will not be as bad as traffic conditions closer to Los Angeles.

Los Angeles International (LAX) - 55 miles

LAX is the largest airport in Southern California. You will find the widest selection of carriers and flight times, however it will also be the most time consuming to get to the Surf and Sand Resort. Expect traffic on the 405 Freeway South between 2:30pm and 7:00pm.

Rental Cars

There are numerous car rental agencies available in the John Wayne Airport and Los Angeles airport terminals. Please also note that there will not be a fee for overnight parking at the Surf and Sand Resort. The normal \$30/night parking fee has been waived for WASSA conference participants.

Shuttle

Taking a shared shuttle from LAX or SNA is the most cost effective method, however also the most time consuming. Due to the shared shuttles, you will likely have to spend time dropping off other travelers on your way to Laguna Beach.

The most popular shuttles are Super Shuttle and Primetime Shuttle

Taxi

Taxis are available from all major airports. Fares will vary, but good estimates are as follows (each way):

Orange County John Way Airport: \$45

Long Beach Airport: \$60+

Los Angeles International Airport: \$100+
